In turn, that reminds me that we are all connected to the One, the great "I AM" of the universe who created, redeemed and sustains us, who are all made to reflect God's Light and Image to God's world all around us.

Dear Friends,

I write this aboard the Condor Liberation as it makes its way at three quarters speed due to some technical problem they have, perhaps wisely, left unexplained. In recent weeks, I have left or arrived via different ports as compared to previously published schedules. It's all rather inconvenient but that's it, really, just a bit irritating. On this occasion I am accompanied by my mother who no longer wished to make such journeys on her own. Looking out of the window she remarked that, in the middle of the Channel, with no land in sight, it made her realise just how desperate people must be to pay money that they don't have in order to attempt to cross these busy shipping lanes in small boats, seeking a better life in the UK. Desperate enough to travel and sometimes with babes in arms. This reminds me how blessed we are to have the freedom to choose to come and go whenever we want to - assuming we can afford the fare, which itself can prove prohibitive.

I'm able to bring my Mum over, having attended the annual Conference for Superintendents. We meet for three days, and two nights, for worship, mutual support and sharing and to hear the current trends and initiatives that are happening across our Connexion. On one occasion I was sitting at a table with the President of Conference and her husband, both of whom I know quite well from when we worked together in my last district. Also around the table were current colleagues from the Southampton District as well as two people I first met at theological college some 27 years ago!
